This experienced teacher/mentor will help you: set goals, cultivate student relationships, mitigate bias, plan lessons and analyze student work to create an Optimal Learning Environment for all students. They will also observe your instruction, and provide you with constructive, growth-producing feedback. However, they are not evaluating you. That is your site administrator's job. Your mentor is your confidante. Please send me documentation from your Year 1 program so that I can validate your Year 2 status and set up a time for a brief personal conversation that will help facilitate your mentor match.

All workshops are held at different locations around the South Bay, so select the one that works best for your schedule, regardless of your district of employment.
